Are you RED or AMBER? How to BOOST your Retirement Planning Status

If your Member Benefit Statement shows that you are in the Red or Amber category, you may need to TAKE ACTION to boost your retirement savings:

- Save as much as you can!
 - Increase your contribution rate from 6.5% to 7.5%
 - Make Additional Voluntary Contributions
 - Office Staff: Set your Pensionable Earnings Percentage to 90%
 - Office Staff: Make your STI bonus pensionable
- Make sure you preserve your savings (if you leave OM)
- Save for as long as you can!
