Drafting your Last Will and Testament

If you **DO NOT have a Will**, your assets will be distributed according to the provisions put forth in the Intestate Succession Act, which stipulates that your assets are fairly transferred to:

- Your spouse and child(ren) if applicable;
- Your siblings and parents *if applicable*; and
- extended family if required.

However you run the risk of your assets not being distributed in the way you intended. There could be delays in appointing an executor (who will be somebody that you did not intend to choose) and unnecessary costs involved.
